WHAT WAS HAPPENING IN THE CENTER DURING SEPTEMBER

In September, our Center was flooded with people, and we opened 29 in-person courses of Czech language for adults.

Furthermore, we organized 2 open courses of Czech language on the topic of food and drinks and fashion and clothing, 3 expert courses aimed at accommodation, healthcare and the obligations connected with residence in the Czech Republic or adaptation-integration courses, which were a useful first step for living in the Czech Republic.

We ventured out with our stand during the Day of international minorities to Babylonfest, which was absolutely phenomenal, and we visited the Břeclav festival of Ochutnávky mezinárodních kuchyní (International Cuisine Tastings) in connection with the Day of Social Services.

We were not lazing around with consultations, either. We were helping you with the assistance of our partners OPU and DCHB in legal and social areas, as well as with questions about everyday life. HOW TO REGISTER FOR THE ADAPTATION-INTEGRATION COURSE?

The majority of foreigners from countries outside the EU, who were given the approval of long-term residency or permanent residency after 1.1.2021 must complete the adaptation-integration courses.

The sign in and registration to the courses takes place through internet reservation for foreigners of the Ministry of Interior on this website - frs.gov.cz.

SALE OF REVENUE STAMPS FOR MOI IMMIGRATION OFFICE BRNO













Starting from September, you can buy revenue stamps in the waiting areas of the Immigration Office of MOI.

It is possible to buy stamps each Monday and Wednesday from 8.00 to 16.00 o'clock. They are sold by the workers of the Diocesan Charity Brno on site.

The stamps are sold in value of 50 CZK, 100 CZK, 200 CZK, 500 CZK and 1,000 CZK.

For now, it is only possible to pay by cash.
