CZECH LANGUAGE COURSES FOR NON-EU CITIZENS

We would like to inform you about Czech language courses of Spring 2022, which we will open in the week from 24 January 2022. The courses are for all citizens with a stay over 90 days, who live in the South Moravian region and who are not citizens of the EU, nor do they have Czech citizenship. The courses are divided into levels according to the knowledge of the Czech language, and they take place twice a week for three months. Registration to the courses starts from 9.1.2022 from 18.00 o'clock ONLINE through the Center for Foreigners JMK website. We are looking forward to seeing you.

CZECH LANGUAGE COURSES FOR EU CITIZENS

We would also like to inform you about Czech language courses for EU citizens, which we will open from 22. February. Courses are for all citizens of the European Union and the European Economic Area, who live in the South Moravian region for a long time. The courses are divided into levels according to the knowledge of the Czech language, and they take place twice a week for three months. Registration into the courses starts from 30.1.2022 from 18.00 o'clock ONLINE through the Center for Foreigners JMK website. We are looking forward to seeing you.

CHRISTMAS HOLIDAYS IN THE CZECH REPUBLIC

Christmas is a Christian holiday, which is celebrated in the Czech Republic for three days. Before them comes Advent time, baking of sweets, lighting candles on the Advent wreaths, buying presents and the Day of St. Nicolas, who comes the 5th of December with a demon and an angel and brings gifts to good children.

24th of December is Christmas Eve. People decorate the tree and eat traditional food for dinner, such as fish soup, fried carp, and potato salad. Presents are unwrapped after the dinner. In the Czech Republic, baby Jesus brings the presents.

25th of December is called Christmas Day (the literal translation is the Godly Christmas feast day), and it celebrates the birth of Jesus Christ. It is celebrated with close family and what shouldn't be missing on the table is a goose, duck or turkey with cabbage and dumplings.

26th of December is St. Stephen's Day, during which Christmas carolers came and visited and were rewarded with a small snack. This tradition died out and people usually spend this day surrounded by family and close ones.

After Christmas comes New Year's Eve with the midnight fireworks and New Year's Day. During this day, Czech families cook meals from lentils, so the people feasting will keep their money throughout the new year. On the other hand, poultry is forbidden, so luck would not fly away, and it is very important to remember the saying "As on New Year's, then throughout the year."
