

## Czech Courses and Services for EU Foreigners

For five years the Centre for Foreigners of the South Moravian region offers support to EU foreigners. The support is mainly in Czech language courses, multicultural activities, assistance with administrative issues and expert socio-cultural lectures. All of our services are for free.

## **Expert Lectures**

The Centre organizes expert lectures either online or in person at Mezírka 1. Through these lectures foreigners can be introduced to the Czech social and legal system. They can then easily deal with everyday life in the Czech Republic; how to enroll a child into school, what to deal with when looking for a job, how to file a tax return, how to obtain Czech citizenship and other.



Accompanying assistance to offices or help with forms Our information worker Jitka Koudelková helps EU foreigners in common situations of everyday life. She escorts them into state and commercial institutions like the bank, the magistrate, health insurance company, school, trade licensing office, real estate and others. Koudelková also helps foreigners to understand short letters, e-mails or forms. Last but not least she deals with simple residence issues, obtaining a driver's license, establishing a trade license and others. ## Adaptation-Integration Courses



Adaptation-integration courses are mandatory for foreigners from some third countries. They are primarily for those who obtained their residence permits after January 1, 2021.

Thanks to the courses you will be introduced to Czech cultural customs; you will be able to orient yourself in Czech society and you will find out how to behave in regular, everyday situations. The following topics are discussed in the courses: government offices, employment, education, healthcare and others. You will also obtain information about areas of everyday life in the Czech Republic. In May the courses will be in these languages: English, Ukrainian, Russian, French and Mongolian.
