Learn Czech

Do you have trouble understanding your Czech colleagues? Do you want to improve your Czech? The Centre for Foreigners offers free grammar and conversation courses which are held in person and online. The Centre also organizes summer experiential courses where learning Czech is connected with activities in Brno and its surroundings, such as visiting Špilberk Castle, a trip to the Brno dam, visiting Brno's villas

and a tour of the Mahen theatre. Mark your calendars: you can register for Czech courses for Non-EU citizens starting 28 August and for EU citizens from 4 September.

Deal with Forms and Ask for Help

Legal and social consultants at the Centre for Foreigners can help you when dealing with residence issues, offer assistance when asking for citizenship, help you write a written request or fill out a form. All of these services are free of charge. They can also accompany you to governmental offices, to the doctor or when enrolling your child in school or kindergarten.

Come to a Lecture

The Centre also organizes expert lectures free of charge. Thanks to them you will be

introduced to the Czech social and legal system. You can then easily deal with everyday situations in the Czech Republic; how to enroll your child into school, what to do when looking for a job, how to fill out tax returns and how to obtain Czech citizenship, among others.

Take an Adaptation-Integration Course

Thanks to these courses you will be introduced to Czech cultural traditions and be able to orient yourself in Czech society. The following areas are discussed in the adaptation courses: governmental offices, employment, education, health, and others. You will also obtain information about family life, accommodation, business, insurance, and other aspects of everyday life in the Czech Republic.

The courses are mandatory for some foreigners from third countries, in particular for those who obtained their residence permits after January 1, 2021. In July and August, you can take the courses in English, Ukrainian, Russian, Serbian, Vietnamese or Turkish.

Create, Have Fun and Meet New People

Do you want to try something new and meet other foreigners in Brno? Come to our multicultural workshops. The Centre for Foreigners organizes creative workshops, self-development workshops and artistic workshops during which you can create your own herbarium or sandals.
